

**BLANCO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING \* MARCH 10, 2008**

The Board of Trustees of Blanco ISD held a regular Board meeting on March 10, 2008 at the Blanco High School Library. Board President Matt Herden called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Trustees Present: Matt Herden, Mary Ann Weaver, Charles Riley, David Behrends, Troy Immel, Bernie San Miguel, Kirk Felps

In Open Forum, Christine McGinnis expressed concerns to the Board about Pre-K. Ann Broyles expressed concerns regarding conditions and Pre-K. Mike McClure expressed his views concerning the students and school with dignity and reminded the Board about Math & Science night at the elementary on Tuesday, March 11<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m.

Matt Herden introduced special surprise guest State Representative Patrick Rose, who discussed school finance and funding.

A motion was made by Troy Immel and seconded by Mary Ann Weaver to approve the consent agenda items (minutes of prior meeting, ratification of expenditures for the month of February 2008). All were in favor with board members abstaining from voting for items indicated.

Attorney Steve Dubner reviewed proposed Architectural Planning Service Agreement between the school district and Fromberg Associates, Ltd.

Shirley Beck gave a report on the Historic Blanco High School renovation progress.

A motion was made by Charles Riley and seconded by Bernie San Miguel to approve Board of Trustees Certification for 2008. All were in favor.

A motion was made by Kirk Felps and seconded by Mary Ann Weaver to approve revised school calendar for 2008-2009. All were in favor.

A motion was made by Troy Immel and seconded by Bernie San Miguel to approve the District and Campus Improvement Plans for 2008-09 as presented. All were in favor.

A motion was made by Mary Ann Weaver and seconded by Charles Riley to approve Blanco County Agreement for use of handicap voting machine in the May 2008 school board elections. All were in favor.

A motion was made by Bernie San Miguel and seconded by Charles Riley to approve second reading of TASB Board Policy Update 82. All were in favor.

The Board held the first reading of Guidelines for Addressing Dating Violence. No action.

A motion was made by Bernie San Miguel and seconded by Troy Immel to approve the Administrative Regulations Regarding Visitors at School Identified as Sex Offenders. (Supplement to GKC (LOCAL) – Community Relations: Visitors at the Schools). All were in favor.

The meeting adjourned to closed session at 8:30 p.m.

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The meeting reconvened to open session at 8:50 p.m.

A motion was made by Bernie San Miguel and seconded by Charles Riley to rescind last month's motion and vote to issue a probationary contract to high school Principal Dustin Barton and to now issue a (2) year term contract to high school Principal Dustin Barton. All were in favor.

A motion was made by Kirk Felps and seconded by Bernie San Miguel to accept teacher contracts for the 2008-2009 school year as presented by campus principals and accept resignations of Jacqueline Brown (middle school special education) and Danielle Frei (middle school math). All were in favor.

A motion to adjourn was made by Troy Immel and seconded by Charles Riley. All were in favor.
